FABRIC RUCHING
1-DAY WORKSHOP
with CANDACE KLING

TOOLS: scissors for silk
 scissors for paper
 ball head pins
 needles & thread
 tape measure
 C-Thru ruler, 6", 12", or 18"
 notebook & pencil/pen (2 colors)
 folder for 8½ x11 handouts
 Scotch brand or generic Magic Tape - ½" or ¾"

SUPPLIES: 1 yard silk fabric. Think china, stone-washed,
 charmeuse, organdy, thai silk/dupioni, taffeta,
 whatever! Silk scarves or garments to cut up are an
 option.

The supplies listed are minimums. The more the merrier. Bring
alternative materials that interest you. Be experimental. See you

FABRIC RUCHING CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
OPTIONAL CUTTING TO DO BEFORE CLASS
1-DAY WORKSHOP
with CANDACE KLING

FIRST:
Cut off selvages of fabric, 2 ½" wide, 2 yards total. This could be
several pieces.

SECOND:

Cut 2 yards of 2 ½" wide bias strips.

CONTINUE:

Cut a rectangle 6 ½" x 18"

Cut a rectangle 6" x 9"

Cut two rectangles 5" x 18"

Cut a 13" square on the bias

These pieces can be cut from various scrap in your collections. They don't have to be all from the same fabric. Each will make a separate sample. Please bring your leftover scraps and any other fabrics that interest you to class.
